- Coordinates congregational Jubilee, Mother Bachmann anniversary celebrations;
- Connects with Franciscan Federation and shares resources/information with congregation.

Young Adult Engagement Minister/part-time: open position

 Collaborates in developing and implementing ways to invite, accompany, and empower young adults in engaging Franciscan spirituality and values towards personal growth and social transformation.

Justice Minister/part-time: Sr. Joanne Clavel

• Oversees the justice and advocacy efforts of the congregation; collaborates with the various committees.

Director of Companions/part-time: Colleen Collins

- Oversees and administers the Companions Relationship;
- Collaborates with the Charism Engagement Minister, coordinators of faith groups and advisory council of the Franciscan Companions in Mission.
